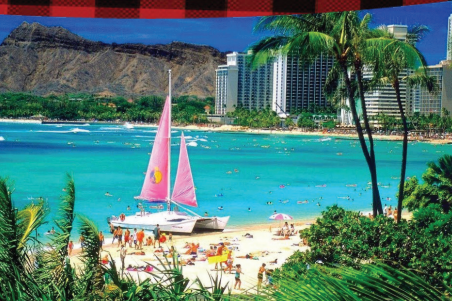

DAY 2-4: WEDNESDAY, FEB 13 - FRIDAY, FEB 15 WAIKIKI BEACH, HAWAII
