**DAY 1-2: FRIDAY, JULY 24 & SATURDAY, JULY 25
CORNER BROOK, NEWFOUNDLAND**

2:30 pm A warm welcome to one and all as we meet our fellow travel companions at the Maple Leaf Lounge in the Kingston Shrine Club, 3260 Princess St. at Collins Bay Rd. Let's check in with your Maple Leaf Tour Director before we depart to begin our Newfoundland Experience! Depart Kingston for Toronto Pearson Airport for our Air Canada flight to **Deer Lake, NL**. Arrive Deer Lake International Airport (YDF) where you will be met by your local Tour Director and Driver.

Depart Toronto 8:30 PM - Arrive Deer Lake 12:40 AM

Wednesday August 5 - St. John's to Toronto AC693

Depart St. John's 1:50 PM - Arrive Toronto 3:55 PM

We will check into our hotel the Deer Lake Horizon Hotel (709) 635-3232, in the early hours of July 25, you will have time to rest this morning. This afternoon you will enjoy local touring in **Corner Brook** prior to checking into your accommodations for your first night in Newfoundland & Labrador, Glynnmill Inn, Corner Brook, (709) 634-5181. 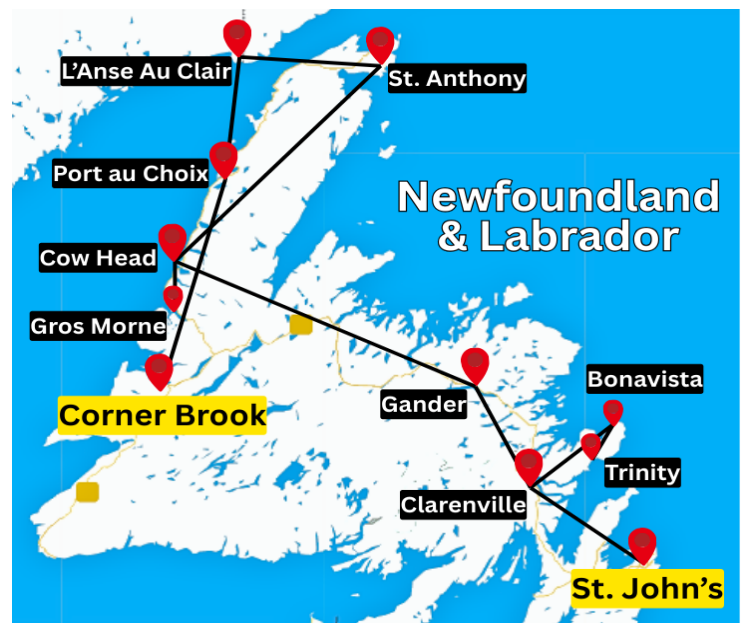
**DAY 3: SUNDAY, JUL 26
CORNER BROOK -PORT AU CHOIX**

Start your journey up the great northern peninsula through **Gros Morne National Park** - to be enjoyed later during your tour - to the fishing community of **Port au Choix** to learn of ancient cultures. The Port au Choix Peninsula juts slightly out into the Gulf of St. Lawrence on

Newfoundland's northwest coast and people have lived here for 5,500 years. This evening we will stay at the Sea Echo Motel, (709) 861-3777. (B) (L) (D)

**DAY 4: MONDAY, JULY 27
PORT AU CHOIX - L'ANSE AU CLAIR**

Board the **ferry** from **St. Barbe** to cross the **Strait of Belle Isle to Labrador**. Continue to **Red Bay National Historic Site, a UNESCO World Heritage Site**, where the Basques had a whaling station in the 16th century. This mystical place takes the essence of Labrador coastal living and transposes it onto a tapestry of rich culture and history. Spend the night in Labrador at the Northern Light Inn, Phone (709) 931-2332. (B) (D)



DAY 5: TUESDAY, JULY 28

L'ANSE AU CLAIR - ST. ANTHONY

Return to Newfoundland and travel to **L'Anse aux Meadows National Historic Site**, the first cultural discovery in the world to receive recognition as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Hear of the **Vikings** who walked here over a thousand years ago before continuing on to your **St. Anthony** accommodations at the Haven Inn, (709) 454-9100. (B) (D)

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, JULY 29

ST. ANTHONY - COW HEAD

Enjoy a morning whale watching **boat tour** in **St. Anthony**. Once your boat tour is complete, visit **Grenfell Heritage Properties** before travelling to **Cow Head** in **Gros Morne National Park** for a two-night stay at the Shallow Bay Motel, (709) 243-2471. (B) (D)

DAY 7: THURSDAY, JULY 30

GROS MORNE TOURING

Discover why **Gros Morne National Park**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, is truly one of the highlights of your trip with a **scenic boat tour** on **Bonne Bay**; be on the look-out for the bald eagles that frequent the deep waters of the fjord. Also visit the **Tablelands**; this mountain of flat-topped rock of a kind usually found only deep in the earth's mantle is an awe-inspiring sight. Today will be an unforgettable experience; some say the scenery that Gros Morne offers is unequalled in Eastern Canada. (B) (L) (D)

DAY 8: FRIDAY, JULY 31 - COW HEAD - GANDER

Have your camera ready as your time in **Gros Morne National Park** draws to a close. Travel through Central Newfoundland on to **Gander**, famous as the basis of the hit Broadway Musical, **Come From Away**. Learn about the hospitality and generosity of the local residents during the aftermath of the September 11, 2001 attacks when 38 airplanes unexpectedly landed there. Also visit the **North Atlantic Aviation Museum** which hosts a variety of artifacts and displays chronicling Gander's role in the development of transatlantic aviation. This evening we will stay at the Sinbad's Hotel and Suites, Gander (709)651-2678). (B)



DAY 9: SATURDAY, AUG 1 - GANDER - CLARENVILLE

A scenic drive along the rocky coast of **Notre Dame Bay** leads to the beautiful outport of **Twillingate** where you will visit **Long Point Lighthouse** and the **Prime Berth Fishery & Heritage Centre**. Keep your camera close at hand for wildlife as you drive through **Terra Nova National Park** and on to **Clarenville**, your home for the next two nights, where we will stay at the Quality Hotel Clarenville (709 466-1717). (B) (L) (D)

DAY 10: SUNDAY, AUG 2 - BONA VISTA & TRINITY

Today you will experience two quaint, historic towns. First, visit **Bonavista**, where John Cabot first arrived in North America in 1497. Learn about the hard life of the light keepers at **Cape Bonavista Lighthouse Provincial Historic Site** before continuing on to charming **Trinity**. Stroll the lanes and explore the many historic buildings preserved from the 18th century. (B) (L) (D)

DAY 11: MONDAY, AUG 3 CLARENVILLE - ST. JOHN'S

Continue on to the intriguing old seaport of **St. John's**, your home for the next two nights. North America's oldest city and Newfoundland's capital boasts a stunning location in the **granite cliffs** and slopes of the **Avalon Peninsula**. Enjoy a city tour featuring the Victorian architecture of the downtown area, the busy modern waterfront, the **Cathedral of St. John the Baptist**, **Confederation Building**, and the panoramic view from **Signal Hill**. **Continues...**

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Continues... Our final hotel for our last night in this amazing province will be at the Delta St. John's (709) 739-6404. (B) (D)

DAY 12: TUESDAY, AUG 4 - LOCAL TOURING

This morning, visit **Bay Bulls** for one of the highlights of your trip, a boat tour in the **Witless Bay Ecological Reserve** to search for puffins and other seabirds. Next is a visit to the most easterly point in North America, **Cape Spear National Historic Site**. The afternoon is yours to explore **St. John's** at your leisure. (B)

DAY 13: WEDNESDAY, AUG 5 - DEPART FOR HOME

Upon checking out of our hotel we will transfer to the airport for our flight to Toronto where our coach will be waiting to bring us home. With wonderful memories we will be left to wonder "Where are we going next?" (B)
